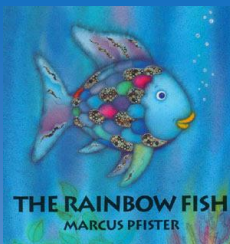


Things you could do at home:

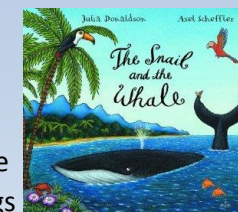
