School Uniform Policy

At Ilchester School we encourage our children to take pride in their appearance and to look smart in their school uniform. Uniform is set out as below. All items are non-gender specific.

Compulsory Items for all Year Groups

- Blue logoed v-neck or crew neck sweatshirt or cardigan
- Grey straight leg trousers (not combat or skinny)
- Grey shorts (not combat)
- Grey A- line or box pleat skirt
- Grey pinafore dress
- Sky blue and white gingham dress
- Grey socks (not trainer socks)
- White socks (pupils can only wear white socks with summer uniform)
- Grey tights
- Black sensible school shoes (not boots, ballerina style, trainer style, heels, pumps or canvas shoes)
- Logoed book bag

Compulsory Items for Junior Children (year groups 3-6)

- White collared shirt (long or short sleeved)
- School tie

Compulsory Items for Infant children (year groups Rec-2)

- White logoed polo shirt or a white collared shirt (long or short sleeved) and school tie

PE Kit – must be in a separate drawstring bag.

- Plain white t-shirt
- Black shorts
- Black joggers - optional (no leggings)
- Trainers or plimsolls (not needed at start of Reception year)

Other Matters

- Jewellery (studs are acceptable for pierced ears) should not be worn.
- Extremes of hair style are discouraged.

Pre-school

Uniform is not compulsory for children attending the preschool, however we recognise that for parents it is often simpler to adopt uniform items and the very nature of a preschool learning environment means that the children do get messy. A logoed jumper is desirable and parents are free to use any other item from the list above.
